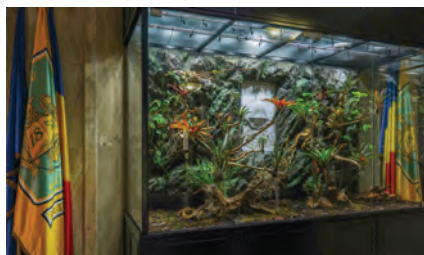

Discover Bucharest

Known for its wide, tree-lined boulevards, glorious Belle Époque buildings and a reputation for the high life (which in the 1900s earned its nickname of “Little Paris”), Bucharest, Romania’s largest city and capital, is today a bustling metropolis. Bucharest offers more than 40 museums, including the largest outdoor Village museum.

City highlights

- **Theaters:** Bucharest National Theatre, Bulandra, Notarra, Metropolis, Odeon etc.
- **Classical music:** Romanian National Opera, Romanian Athenaeum etc.
- **Historical sights:** Parliament Palace, Royal Palace, Arch of Triumph, Historical center etc.
- **Cinemas, concerts, festivals**



Parliament Palace (Palatul Parlamentului)

Built at the special request of Nicolae Ceaușescu, leader of Romania’s Communist Party, the colossal Parliament Palace - formerly known as “People’s House” (Casa Poporului) - is the world’s second largest administrative building after the U. S. Pentagon. It took 20,000 workers and 700 architects to build this massive structure that boasts 12 stories, 1,100 rooms, a 350-ft.-long lobby and four underground levels, including an enormous nuclear bunker.





Royal Palace (Palatul Regal)

Erected between 1927 and 1937 in neoclassical style, the palace was home to King Carol II and to his son, King Mihai I, until 1947, when the monarchy was abolished in Romania. It was inside the halls of this palace that King Mihai, aged 18, led a coup that displaced the pro-Nazi government during the World War II and put Romania on the Allies' side. Today, the former Royal palace houses the Romanian National Art Museum.

Arch of Triumph (Arcul de Triumf)

Initially built of wood in 1922 to honor the bravery of Romanian soldiers who fought in World War I, Bucharest's very own Arch of Triumph was finished in 1936. Designed by the architect, Petre Antonescu, the Arch stands 85 feet high. An interior staircase allows visitors to climb to the top for a panoramic view of the city. The sculptures decorating the structure were created by leading Romanian artists, including Ion Jalea, Constantin Medrea and Constantin Baraschi.



Romanian Athenaeum (Ateneul Român)

The work of French architect Albert Galleron, who also designed the National Bank of Romania, the Athenaeum was completed in 1888, financed almost entirely with money donated by the general public. With its high dome and Doric columns, the Athenaeum resembles an ancient temple. Romanian Athenaeum is one of the most important concert halls.

History since 1852

The University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest is the oldest and the largest institution of higher agricultural education in Romania.

Our story begins with the act signed by the Prince Barbu Știrbei in **1852**, establishing the **Institute of Agriculture of Pantelimon**.



In **1855**, the **School for Veterinary Education** opened its doors. Agricultural and veterinary education evolved in parallel towards ever more extensive forms, in correlation with the growing need for specialists and scientific progress in the two fields.

On 1 august **1868**, the Prince Carol laid the foundation stone for the building that was to house the **Central School of Agriculture and Forestry of Herăstrău**, on the estate with the same name.

The first experimental teaching farm in the country and the first institution dedicated to agricultural research in Romania, known as the **Agronomic Station Bucharest**, was founded there.



In the following decades, agricultural education developed and the institution successively bore the following names: The Higher School of Agriculture of Herăstrău (1915), the Academy of Higher Agronomic Studies (1929), the Faculty of Agronomy - integrated into the Polytechnic School of Bucharest (1938), the Agronomic Institute of Bucharest (1948). In 1952, the name of the great patriot Nicolae Bălcescu was added to the Agronomic Institute. In **1992**, it was renamed the **University of Agronomic Sciences**, and in **1995** it became the **University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest**.

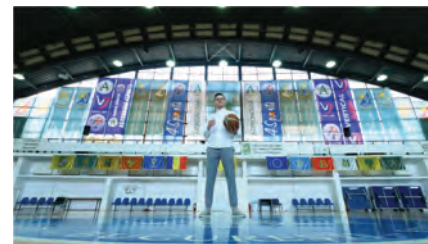

Our challenge is to improve animal husbandry methods and develop processing technologies to **optimise the utilisation of animal products** with high nutritional value.



What is the Faculty of Animal Production Engineering and Management?

It means being a specialist in animal husbandry (equine, sheep, goats, cattle), poultry, bees, fish, animal husbandry facilities, fur and game animals, as well as in animal products processing.

The Bachelor of Animal Husbandry study program provides skills for a professional career in the areas of equine, swine, sheep and goats, cattle, poultry; beekeeping; fish farming; animal husbandry facilities; fur and game animals; animal product processing; management and marketing.

The Bachelor of Food Processing Technology study program is part of the Food Engineering field. Graduates will acquire specific skills in all food processing technologies, which will enable them to manage activities in food production units.

The Bachelor of Consumer and Environmental Protection study program trains specialists in food quality control, food authentication and identification of counterfeit products, air and environmental quality control. Graduates will be involved in the coordination and control of activities in establishments.

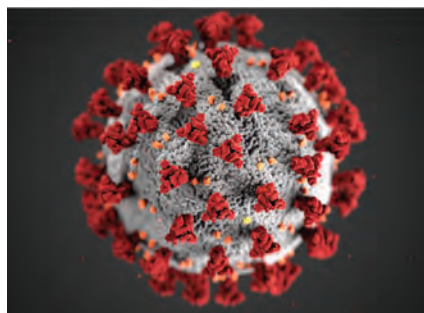

Biotechnology in the food industry

Refers to innovation in traditional food production technologies, in particular by fermentative methods, with the aim of obtaining products with high nutritional value, in full respect of consumer safety.

Agricultural Biotechnology

Also known as plant biotechnology, it is a branch of agricultural science that involves the use of techniques to adapt plants to specific needs, from providing healthy food to protecting the environment.



Medical-Veterinary Biotechnology

It is an emerging field where biotechnology standards are linked to the **process of obtaining medicines** for human and veterinary use. The majority of medicines on the market are bioformulated, such as antibodies, nucleic acid products and vaccines.



Pharmaceutical companies are using **biotechnology principles** such as recombinant DNA technology to design and make more effective protein-based drugs such as erythropoietin and rapid-acting insulin

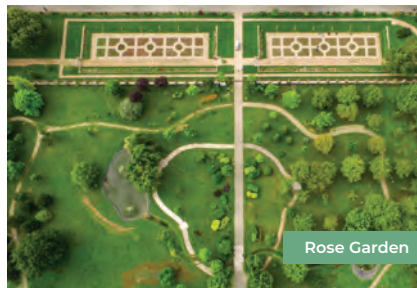

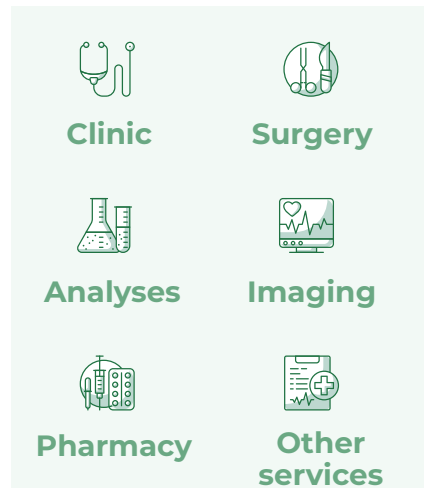

EU COUNTRIES

1. Registration for admission

Registration period **July – August**

The application process for USAMV Bucharest faculties is done online on **admitere.usamv.ro**

Citizens of the **European Union member states**, of the **European Economic Area member states** (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway) and of the **Swiss Confederation** may apply for admission, including state-funded places, in the same conditions as Romanian students.

2. CNRED diploma recognition

Candidates who have a diploma obtained in an **EU country other than Romania** need to have their diploma validated by the National Centre for Degree Assessment and Academic Recognition (CNRED) of the Romanian Ministry of Education.

3. Admission documents

- Application form;
- Birth certificate;
- ID/passport;
- 2 photos (3/4);
- High-school diploma;
- Transcript of records from high-school;
- Declaration regarding the authenticity of the documents;
- Diplomas from contests or olympiads;
- Bachelor diploma – if the case;
- Transcript of records for Bachelor studies – if the case (the academic situation for the years of study completed, containing the subjects, grades, number of credits / ECTS and number of course hours for each subject, issued by the higher education institution where the applicant previously studied);
- The certificate for equivalence / recognition from CNRED for the last study diploma;
- Medical certificate;
- Copy of the receipt for the fee requested from CNRED (more details: www.new.cnred.edu.ro/cnred)



The language of the documents should be: Romanian / English / French / Spanish / Italian or certified translation for any other languages.

Diplomas from **Italy, Greece, Spain, Portugal** and **Cyprus** need to bear the Hague Apostil Convention from the authorities of the country that issued the document.

Diplomas issued in countries which are not party of the Hague Convention must be authenticated by the **Ministry of Education** and the **Ministry of Foreign Affairs** of the issuing country and also the **Embassy of Romania** in that country.

4. Admission process

NON-EU COUNTRIES

1. Choose your study programme and contact USAMV Bucharest International Office to submit you application

USAMV Bucharest will submit your application file for admission to studies in Romania to the Directorate-General for International Relations and European Affairs (DGRIAE) of the Ministry of Education (the minimum period of processing the application is 30 days). If a positive decision is reached by the Ministry, a "**Letter of Acceptance**" is issued and sent to the higher education institution and at the diplomatic mission.

2. Obtain study VISA

Once you have received the university letter of acceptance, apply for **student visa** in your country of origin at the diplomatic mission; More information: www.igi.mai.gov.ro
After receiving the Letter of Acceptance, the candidate has to confirm that he/she accepts to enroll at our University, by sending an email with the receipt attesting the payment of the tuition fee for the first academic year. Then, the candidate starts the procedure for obtaining the visa for studies in Romania. Please note that the tuition fee for the first academic year must be paid before submitting the visa application.

3. Admission documents

- Application request to the Ministry of Education for the Letter of Acceptance to studies issuance - in two copies;
 - Birth certificate - certified copy and translation (into English or Romanian);
 - Passport – photocopy;
 - Medical certificate - in an international language;
 - 2 photos 3/4 cm
 - Study diploma (Baccalaureate diploma or equivalent for undergraduate studies; Bachelor diploma or equivalent for master studies) – certified copy and translation (into English or Romanian);
 - Transcript of records (the academic situation for the years of study completed, containing the subjects, grades, number of credits / ECTS and number of course hours for each subject, issued by the higher education institution where the applicant previously studied) certified copy and translation (into English or Romanian);
 - Certificate of linguistic competence - exempted are the candidates coming from states whose official language is the study language of the specialization they have applied for;
- * please prepare the required documents in two sets (one for the Ministry of Education and one for the university).



Candidates should send their **admission documents**, by regular post, to the International Relations Office (Biroul Relații Internaționale - Universitatea de Științe Agronomice și Medicină Veterinară din București, Bd. Mărăști nr. 59, 011464 București, România)

The originals of these documents must be stamped by the **Embassy of Romania** in the issuing country or to bear the **Hague Apostille Convention** from the authorities of the country that issued the documents (only if the respective country is a signatory of the Hague Convention).

If you don't know romanian and wish to enroll in a **Romanian-taught program**, you can attend the **Preparatory Year** for learning romanian language or provide a **Romanian Language Certificate**. The candidates that have attended at least 4 years of study in Romanian language, do not need to pass this language exam. Otherwise, only after passing this language exam, the candidate will be accepted in the first year of study.

CITIZENS OF ROMANIAN ORIGIN

This section applies for candidates of Romanian descent from the Republic of Moldova, Albania, Bulgaria, Greece, Macedonia, Serbia, Croatia, Ukraine, Hungary and Diaspora

The admission process is done in compliance with the methodology of the Ministry of Education and Research regarding higher education. This section applies for candidates of romanian descent, people who freely assume the romanian cultural identity, romanian emigrants, romanian citizens residing abroad.

1. Registration for admission

Registration period **May – July**

The application process for USAMV Bucharest faculties is done online on **admitere.usamv.ro**

2. Admission process

If the application is successful, romanians from everywhere have the obligation to confirm the enrollment by submitting the original and certified documents by post or in person at USAMV Bucharest

3. Admission documents

You can find all enrollment details and the content of the application file you must complete on **international.usamv.ro**

Check our website for the places allocated to Romanians from everywhere and you can access two types of scholarship :

Total scholarship: No tuition fees, with a monthly grant

Partial scholarship: No tuition fees, with no monthly grant

One condition for receiving this type of scholarship is that the studies be carried out only into Romanian. Candidates who do not speak Romanian well enough can follow the Romanian preparatory year (the preparatory year is offered under the same financial terms as the program of study for which the candidate was accepted).

What is the preparatory year? Who is it for?

The Preparatory Year – Romanian Language Course is mandatory for those students who wish to pursue their studies in Romanian language and do not have a valid language certificate in this sense. During this one-year, full-time academic program, the international students will acquire the necessary skills in reading, writing, listening and speaking in Romanian for academic purposes.

The duration of the preparatory course for bachelor degree studies is of **one academic year** while for the master's degree studies, PhD studies and post-graduate studies are at least 6 months.

TUITION FEES per academic year:

1. BACHELOR STUDIES:

- All Study programs: **3,000 euro**;
- Faculty of Veterinary Medicine: **6,030 euro**.

2. MASTER STUDIES:

- All Study programs: **3,000 euro**.

3. PhD STUDIES:

- Engineering and Management of Plant and Animal Resources: **4,200 €**
- Veterinary Medicine Doctoral School: **4,800 euro**.



What do you do after you become a student?

A student's academic status can be: **budgeted student (SB)**, when funding is from the state budget, or **self-financed (ST)**, when funding is through tuition fees.

All those admitted will have details about courses, accommodation and costs available on the dedicated page of the chosen faculty. Regular updates will be posted in the weeks before the start of the university year. Most courses start on the first Monday in October.

Each student's documents are:

- a. **student card**;
- b. **student ID card for transport discount**

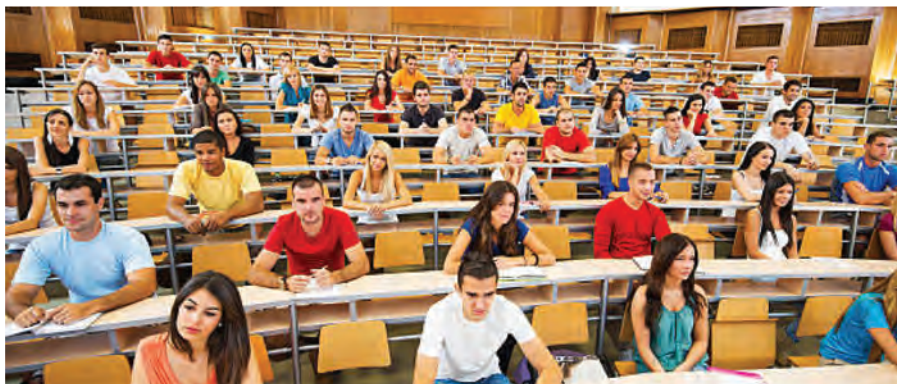
Student assessment

At the USAMV in Bucharest, the forms of assessment provided for in the curriculum are: **examination, colloquium, multi-term course assessment** and **project**.

Students' learning results are assessed with full grades from 10 to 1, with a grade of 5 certifying the acquisition of minimum competences and the passing of an exam.

When are the exam sessions?

- **Winter session**, 3 weeks, at the end of the first semester;
- **Summer session**, 3 weeks, at the end of the second semester;
- **Final session**, 1-2 weeks after the end of the second semester;
- **Re-examination session**, 1 week.



How are ETC granted?

Compulsory credits for

Bachelor studies: minimum 180 (for Biology) and maximum 240 (for Engineering Science programmes).

For the **Faculty of Veterinary Medicine**, which is a European regulated medical sciences degree programme (integrates Cycle I and Cycle II), with a duration of 6 years, the number of credits is 360.

Compulsory credits for **master studies:** minimum 60 and maximum 120.

The allocation of credits per studied subject is as follows:

a) **30 credits/semester** for compulsory and optional subjects, regardless of the form of study;

b) **10 credits for the final examination** (additionally, provided for);

c) **3 credits for the compulsory modern language** which is compulsory for 2-4 semesters, which may be included in the 30 compulsory credits or may be provided in addition if the subject is optional;

d) **3-4 credits for the subject "Physical Education"** (according to Order 1560/23.07. 2007, art. 7);

e) optional subjects will be credited separately and will be recorded in the register;

f) the **specialist practice** will be credited separately in the curriculum and will be completed with a grade; the credits allocated to the practice will be included in the 30 compulsory credits for a semester.

Students in undergraduate programs at USAMV Bucharest, in order to pass from one year of study to another, must obtain:

a) **40 credits**, for transfer from year I to year II;

b) **100 credits**, for transfer from year II to year III;

c) **160 credits**, for transfer from year III to year IV;

d) **200 credits**, for transfer from year IV to year V;

e) **280 credits**, for transfer from year V to year VI.

Research and Development Station for Fruit Growing

The Istrița nursery is located in Săhăteni, Buzău county. The climate is semi-humid, quite warm. The year 1893 marks the beginning of the Istrița nursery, its initial purpose being to propagate vine planting material.

The **first practical school of grafters** in Romania was created in Istrița in 1902.



The Istrița Research and Development Station for fruit growing has two development axes:



It produces and sells fruit trees and berry plants



It produces and sells apples, plums and sweet cherries

Practical learning of modern techniques: drip irrigation, green pruning, canopies to enhance the varieties productive potential and new types of crops.



Tomorrow's challenges are the research you do today.

The Research Centre for Integrated Fruit Growing

encompasses and relates the actions in this field with the needs of the Fruit Growing Department.

The Istrița nursery produces a wide range of apple, pear, quince, plum, apricot, peach, almond, cherry and sour cherry grafted trees. The trees are grown in the **tree nursery** during a two-year cycle.

Moara Domnească Research and Development Station for Agronomy – a story with a royal scent

Moara Domnească Farm is one of the USAMV's teaching and research stations, just 15km away from Bucharest. It's a little piece of heaven, where USAMV students get **top practical training**.

How many of us know that varieties of grains, vegetables or fruit trees can be improved in the laboratory, but then left to develop, by natural means, with good results and without affecting our health?



USAMV students, teachers, master students, PhD students and researchers prepare breeding, research and testing programmes for **new varieties and hybrids** of grains, fruit trees, etc., using the most modern technologies in the field.

The Interra Farm Network concept, a pilot farm model for waste management, has been implemented in Moara Domnească Farm and it is a centre for training and promotion of technologies and good agricultural practices for sustainable agriculture.



The didactic farm includes **315 ha field crop farm**, a livestock and fishery sector - **19 ha of water surface**, 2 cattle sheds, a fruit cold store with controlled temperature, humidity and atmosphere for the storage of fruit with a capacity of 900 tons, a **modern poultry breeding farm** (geese, ducks), a mansion where Tolstoy lived and many other modernly equipped premises for the accommodation and training of future specialists.
